Course Title: In Motion Targets — 4-Day Sniper Instructor Training Course

Duration: 4 days (0800–1700 daily; 60-minute lunch + short breaks)

Course Overview:

Train experienced sniper/spotter operators to become competent instructors who can design, deliver, assess, and manage safe, legally defensive precision rifle training including long-range and low-light employment.

Learning Objectives:

- Explain and apply applicable use-of-force policy and range SOPs when planning and conducting sniper training.
- Design, deliver, and assess clear lesson objectives using adult learning methods.
- Demonstrate system zero procedures, create accurate dope cards, and verify ballistic performance.
- Coach marksmanship fundamentals and remediate shooter errors effectively.
- Plan and execute mid- and long-range engagements with spotter corrections, and conduct low-light/NVG fundamentals.
- Lead mission-level scenario briefs (overwatch/hostage/vehicle) and perform AARs and documentation.
- Serve as an effective RSO and maintain range safety, emergency response, and training records.

Prerequisites / Eligibility:

- Active sworn law enforcement status; agency authorization to attend.
- Prior sniper/operator certification (agency or recognized provider).
- Firearms instructor credential or agency endorsement.
- Current TCCC (or equivalent) and CPR.
- Clean disciplinary record.

Daily Structure (typical):

- 0800–0815 — Morning admin & safety check
- 0815–0945 — Morning module (classroom/theory)
- 0945–1000 — Break
- 1000–1200 — Practical / live-fire block or instructor practicum
- 1200–1300 — Lunch
- 1300–1430 — Afternoon module or continued live fire
- 1430–1500 — Break
- 1500–1700 — Practical / scenarios / micro-lessons / evaluations

Assessments & Certification:

- Written exam: 80% passing (policy/ballistics/safety/NVG basics).
- Instructor practicum: 10-minute lesson + safety brief; assessed on clarity, demo, remediation, safety.
- Live-fire coaching practical: coach a shooter to meet agency standard; demonstrate corrective coaching and spotter integration.
- Final scenario/practical: mission planning, execution, AAR.
- Course pass criteria: ≥80 total (weighted rubric) AND no critical safety failure.

Required Equipment (candidates):

- Primary agency rifle optic & sling; cleaning kit; spare magazines; Tripod capable of supporting Sniper Weapon System to include robust ball head with shooting table and bag / picatinny rail or arca swiss attachment for clip in; Camouflage / Ghillie suit veil / earth tone screen; Standard call out kit per department standards for sniper

deployment; Laser Range finder; Three legged stool; Rear bag for shooting; Robust bipod able to fit on the for-end of the rifle stock.

• Ammunition (recommended 400–700 rounds per candidate — agency may supply). • Eye & ear protection, hydration, notepad, ballistic calculator app / Kestrel if available. • NVG/IR gear if available (agency may supply).
